ACTIVITY 1: NAME THE OCEANS

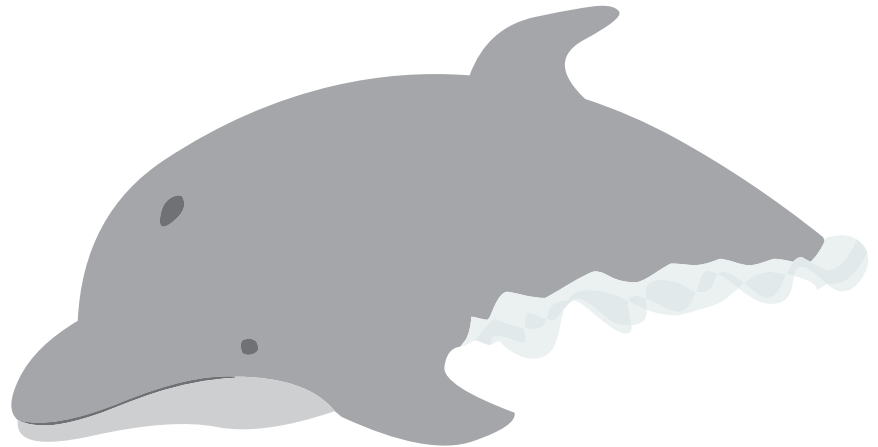
Lesson Objective

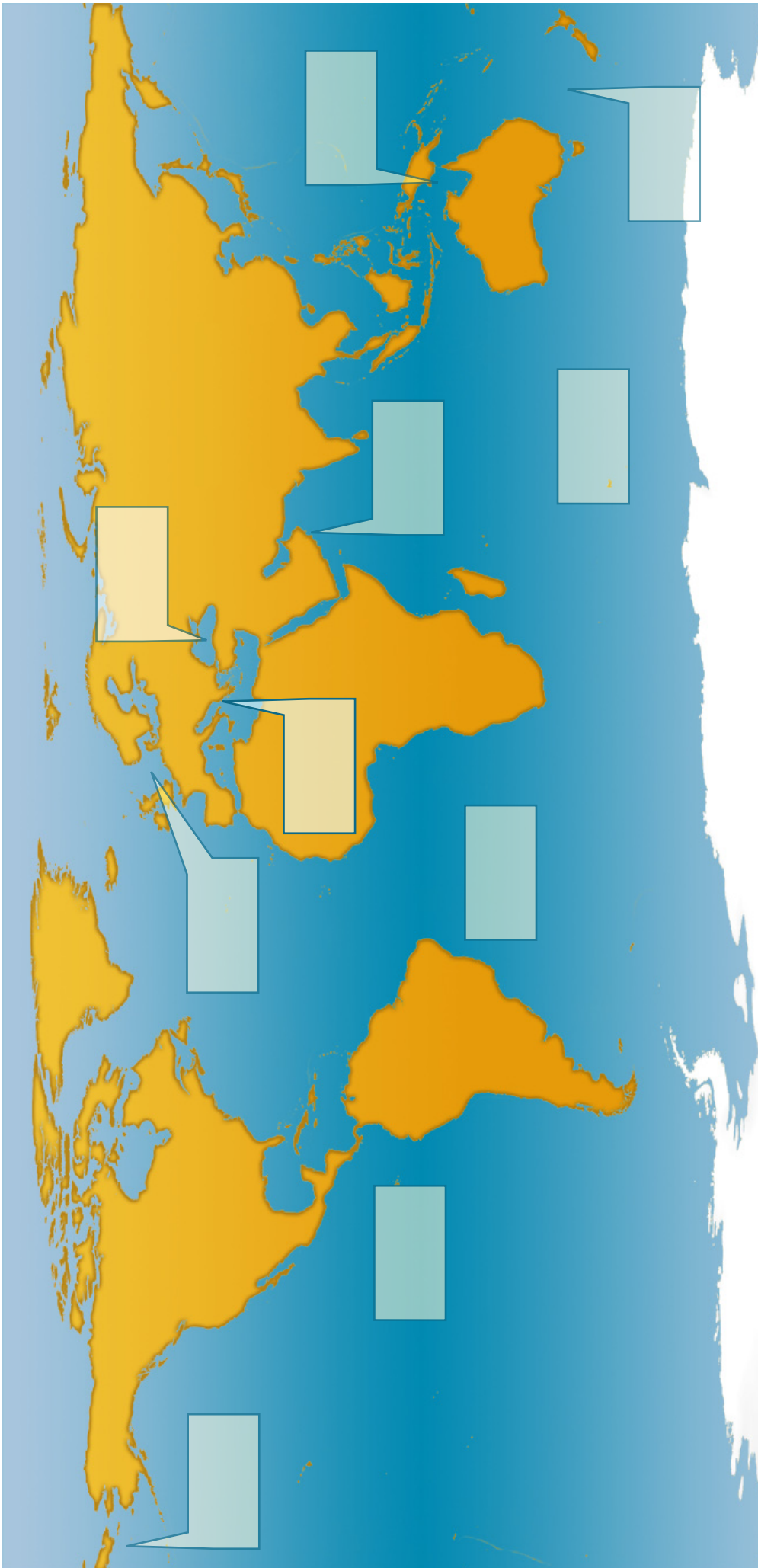
Duffy says,
