#### Lesson Objective

- Make a flicker book of a surfer falling off a wave – a wipeout.

#### Introduction Make a flicker book

You can create a mini animation by using this technique that goes back hundreds of years.

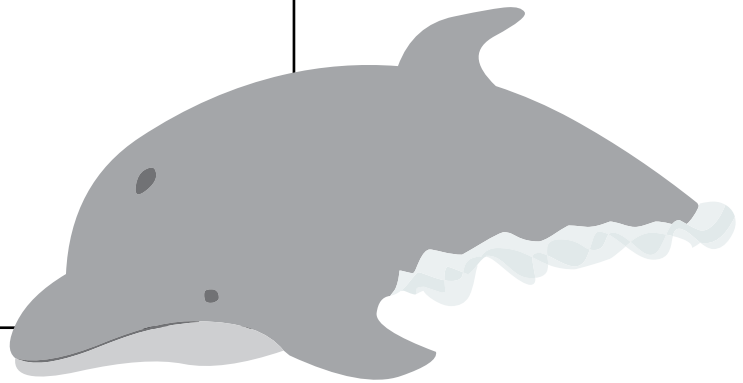
#### You will need:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Coloured pencils
- Scissors
- Stapler.

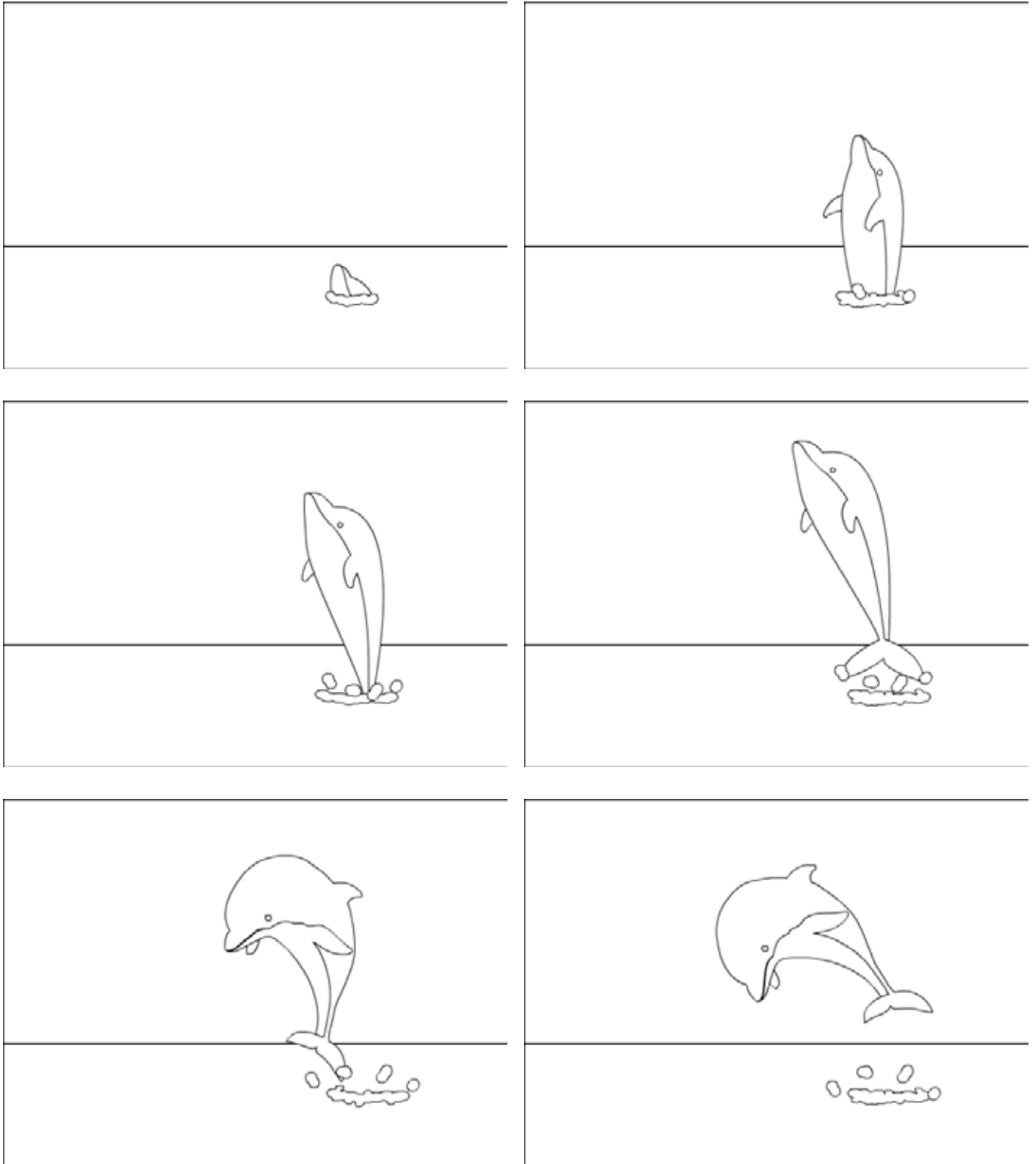
1. Cut two A4 pieces of paper into 12 equal pieces (14.5 x 7cm).
2. Number the pages on the back.
3. Think of a short sequence to animate. Our example shows Duffy jumping in the waves.
4. Draw the sequence on the paper; each page should show the next stage of the story sequence. Once you've drawn the pencil outlines, you could colour them in.
5. When you have finished, put the pages in order, then staple the left edges together.
6. Watch Duffy jumping in the sea!
