To whom it may concern.

On behalf of SAS I have enclosed an item of litter made by your company found on beach in , UK as part of SAS's national Return To Offender weekend (24th & 25th November 2012).

Whilst your company may not be directly responsible for this litter being found on this beach in this instance, we would urge you to do more to prevent litter like this scarring beaches across the UK.

In particular we urge you to:

- To step up 'the anti-littering' message on your products.
- To look at using less harmful packaging to ensure products can be broken down naturally without putting wildlife at risk.
- To promote recycling and/or reuse wherever appropriate.
- To support community beach litter initiatives or anti-litter projects.

Recent research has found 1,981 pieces of beach litter for every kilometre of beach surveyed in the UK. Please help us turn the tide on beach litter.
