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Mucky Monitoring Steps:

- 1. Select your beach. You will not need permission to carry out an individual monitoring event, but please make sure you are allowed access to the beach.
- 2. Download and print the Mucky Monitoring Event Form
- 3. Carry out your Mucky Monitoring Event (instructions on the event form)
- 4. Identify the most littered 1m² area you have monitored and count the number of Sewage Related Debris in it.
- 5. Spell out your beach name and #TBYF using Sewage Related Debris (cotton bud sticks are ideal for this) and share the images on social media using #TBYF and Surfers Against Sewage handles. This is also chance to challenge some of the industry leaders by tagging them in
- 6. Collect all the Cotton Bud sticks you can find (we will use these later see below)
- 7. Submit your completed form back to SAS

The Think Before You Flush Beach Cleanliness scale*:

Items of Sewage Related Debris per 1m ²	<u>Cleanliness level</u>
0	Very Clean
1-3	Minimal Sewage Related Debris present
4-10	Moderate Sewage Related Debris present (TAKE ACTION!)
11-24	Dirty (TAKE ACTION!)
25+	Very Dirty (URGENT ACTIONS NEEDED!)

*The TBYF Cleanliness scale is based on the International Foundation for Environmental Education criteria for cleanliness using the Beach Litter Measuring System
