Foreword

As a marine scientist and conservationist, this documentation of the marine interests of MPs offers an important insight into the level of engagement of UK Parliament on ocean issues. A healthy functioning ocean is critical to our health and wellbeing, but there are immense and growing pressures from climate change, overexploitation, pollution and habitat degradation and loss. We are an island nation defined culturally and economically by the ocean and benefiting from the many values that it provides, from our weather, fisheries, shipping, watersports, coastal tourism to our rich and diverse marine life. Through our UK Overseas Territories we are responsible for 22% of the world's coral reef area and more penguins than any other nation.

Strong political interest and engagement in ocean conservation should go hand-in-hand with our ocean heritage and its fundamental role in our society, but this report suggests there is room for improvement. Nationally, the UK government is committed to achieve clean, healthy, safe, productive and biologically diverse oceans and seas. Internationally, the UK government – with 192 other countries – has signed up to deliver the Sustainable Development Goals by 2030, of which Goal 14 is specifically targeted to 'conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development'. The UK is also a signatory to other key ocean policy commitments, from the Convention on Biological Diversity to The Paris Agreement, and delivering these requires a high level of engagement and ambition from UK Parliament, across all parties.

The report shows that there are some key areas of political engagement, notably around marine protection and ocean plastic pollution. The commitment to deliver a 'Blue Belt' has resulted in some of the largest marine protected areas in the world in our UK Overseas Territories, including the British Indian Ocean Territory and the Pitcairn Islands. Growing public interest and attention around plastic

pollution has resulted in UK Parliament showing ambition and leadership in reducing single use plastics, as one conservation challenge that everyone wants to solve.

UK Parliament is in a strong position to implement ocean conservation policies and actions, informed by good science. The UK has an exceptional history of marine science with some of the world's leading research institutions and scientists across natural, social, economic and technological science. NGOs also play an active role, often providing the important policy interface between people, experts and government, as shown by Surfers Against Sewage's role in the Protect our Waves All Party Parliamentary Group and the Great British Oceans' role in supporting delivery of marine protection.

This is an unprecedented time for the ocean. There is a strong scientific evidence base for the urgent need to act now to protect and restore the ocean. Public awareness and attention on the ocean has never been higher, with a growing recognition that everyone's actions can impact the ocean, but there is a growing portfolio of solutions and optimism too. Brexit offers both an opportunity and a threat for ocean conservation, so this is a vital time for MPs to navigate through this critical stage of the UK's political history in a way that continues to deliver our ocean commitments and a bright future for our blue island nation.

Introduction

Never has ocean conservation received such extensive awareness and attention. The “Blue Planet” effect has meant a large proportion of the population is now conscious of the threats and impacts on our ocean and coastlines. Plastic pollution, water quality, climate change, marine protected areas and fisheries are key issues that must be addressed to protect and enhance our blue spaces. All levels of society have a part to play. From grassroots environmentalists to governments, there are steps every individual and every organisation can take.

Parliament exists to make laws, discuss issues and look at how our taxes are spent to help govern the country. Our elected representatives have a crucial role to play in protecting our environment and leading people towards more environmentally friendly practices. We have already seen the effectiveness of parliamentary laws in protecting the ocean, for example through the 5p bag charge, which has prevented over nine million single-use plastic bags from entering the environment. But, in the wake of Brexit, now, more than ever, the UK Parliament needs to use its powers to prevent further environmental damage and ensure we improve our natural world for everyone and everything to enjoy.

Surfers Against Sewage (SAS) established the Protect Our Waves All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) in 2014. The group currently comprises 26 cross-party Members of Parliament (MPs). As the only marine conservation focused APPG, it leads a discussion on ocean conservation between MPs, NGOs and the wider public.

SAS has published this report, the first Ocean Conservation Register of its kind, to facilitate dialogue between Parliament and those working in the ocean sector. The Register outlines key marine conservation issues and the interest of MPs in them based on MPs’ work since the 2017 general election. It serves as a guide to the 430 MPs who have expressed an interest in these issues, identified through their contributions to debates, support for Early Day Motions and external campaigns, as well as comments in the media.

The Register also includes information on government and opposition environmental teams, the various committees established within Parliament to scrutinise decisions on the environment, and the Protect Our Waves APPG. It provides brief synopses of the main conservation concerns followed by alphabetical lists of MPs who have engaged on them. It then concludes with the contact details of each MP listed in the Register.

Environmental Audit Committee

The remit of the Environmental Audit Committee is to consider the extent to which the policies and programmes of government departments and non-departmental public bodies contribute to environmental protection and sustainable development and to audit their performance against sustainable development and environmental protection targets. In the previous Parliament, the Committee's programme included inquiries on climate change and environmental fiscal measures, as well as sustainable development and environmental protection. Unlike most select committees, the Committee's remit cuts across government rather than focuses on the work of a particular department.

From its beginning in 1997, in carrying out its environmental 'audit' role the Committee has had extensive support from the National Audit Office, providing seconded staff and research and briefing papers.

Mary Creagh MP was elected as Chair of the Committee on Wednesday 12 July 2017. The remaining members of the Committee were formally appointed on Monday 11 September 2017.

Environment, Food and Rural Affairs Committee

The Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (EFRA) Committee is appointed by the House of Commons to examine the expenditure, administration and policy of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs and its associated public bodies.

The EFRA Committee is one of the 19 Select Committees related to Government Departments, established by the House of Commons under Standing Order No. 152. The Committee chooses its own subjects of inquiry on environmental and agricultural topics. Depending on the subject, external deadlines, and the amount of oral evidence the Committee decides to take, an inquiry may last for several months and give rise to a report to the House; other inquiries may simply consist of a single day's oral evidence which the Committee may publish without making a report.

When the Committee has chosen an inquiry it normally issues a press notice outlining the main themes of inquiry and inviting interested parties to submit written evidence. It may also identify possible witnesses and issue specific invitations to them to submit written evidence.

The House has given the Committee the power to send for "persons, papers and records". It, therefore, has powers to insist upon the attendance of witnesses and the production of papers and other material. These formal powers are rarely used.

Neil Parish MP was elected as Chair of the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs Committee on Wednesday 12 July 2017. The remaining members of the Committee were formally appointed on Monday 11 September 2017.

Protect Our Waves All-Party Parliamentary Group



Surfers Against Sewage's Protect Our Waves All-Party Parliamentary Group (POW APPG) provides a unique platform to raise current environmental threats and ocean conservation campaigns directly with politicians and senior civil servants. It is a powerful and unique platform to bring together cross-sectoral stakeholders including environmental charities, NGOs, health experts, businesses and community leaders to evidence and discuss the need for policy drivers and legislative change to better protect the marine environment.

It brings together a broad (cross-party) coalition of MPs who share an interest in ocean conservation issues and often, but not exclusively, represent important coastal communities around the UK. Steve Double MP (Member of Parliament for Newquay & St Austell) is currently the chairman of the POW APPG, leading engagement with MPs, ministers and the government in relation to threats to the UK's marine habitats and the best ways to protect and promote these increasingly important areas. Surfers Against Sewage acts as the secretariat for the group, briefs and informs the members and sets the agenda for each meeting.

The group has to date focused on a people and planet approach, having been initially formed after the delivery of the Protect Our Waves petition, which gathered over 55,000 signatures of support from surfers and other recreational water users, calling for better protection of our beaches and oceans. The petition was delivered to 10 Downing Street in October 2013.

The APPG is ocean conservation focused and currently covers some the most urgent environmental issues facing our ocean including marine plastic pollution, climate change, water quality (including diffuse pollution and sewage impacts) and the threat of coastal developments. However, these are just the current issues, which are reviewed, and the key aim of the group is to protect our beaches and oceans, and particularly sites of special importance from a recreational or ecological perspective.

Plastic Pollution

Plastic pollution has sadly become synonymous with all of our favourite coastal activities - from surfing to swimming, beach holidays to wildlife watching - it is simply an expected part of our experience. But one that we should not, and do not, accept. Plastic pollution is everyone's problem. Every individual can make habitual changes to reduce their reliance on unnecessary single-use plastics.

Parliament has a significant role to play in creating change. We have already seen hugely successful policies delivered through parliament to help tackle plastic pollution. The 5p Bag Charge has seen the use of Plastic Bags drop by 9 billion since October 2015, strong legislation can be replicated to tackle single-use items such as plastic bottles. Deposit return schemes work well in other countries, with return rates of well over 90%. A staggering 38.5 million single-use plastic bottles are used every day in the UK. Only half of these are recycled, with many ending up on beaches and in our ocean. Surfers Against Sewage presented over a quarter of a million signatures to 10 Downing Street to call for action on ocean plastic pollution with a UK-wide deposit return system. On the 28th March 2018, the government announced that a Bottle Deposit Scheme would be introduced in England following a consultation to determine the details of how such a scheme would work, alongside other measures to increase recycling rates as well as working alongside schemes in Scotland and Wales.

There have been a number of noteworthy petitions and motions that have seen nearly a third of all MPs become engaged with plastic pollution. Most recently, Surfers Against Sewage's, Plastic Free Parliament Campaign has received backing from 180 MPs. As part of the wider campaign an Early Day Motion on Plastics in Parliament has also gained signatures from 69 MPs. In May 2018 Parliament announced radical measures to reduce single-use plastic consumption as a direct output of the campaign. Measures including stopping the sale of water in plastic bottles and introducing a levy on single-use coffee cups. A number of Commons and Westminster Hall debates, EDMs and inquiries addressing plastic pollution and solutions has seen widespread interaction and indicates the topic is at the forefront of political debate.

During the Spring 2018 Statement, HM Treasury opened a consultation seeking opinion on the use of the tax system to help eliminate unnecessary single-use plastics. The government will consider all options for using the tax system to address single-use plastic waste and to drive innovation. They want to look across the whole supply chain, from production and retail to consumption and disposal, before deciding on the best course of action.

Water Quality

Water quality has been a key focus of coastal environments since the 1990s. Following long periods of campaigning, investment and strong legislation, water quality in the UK is at an all-time high. However, it is important not to let standards slip and to continue to drive investment to create the best possible water standards for the public to enjoy and the environment to thrive.

When Surfers Against Sewage began, the organisation collated health evidence on the effects of coming into contact with raw sewage, put pressure on water companies to improve sewerage infrastructure and pushed decision makers for stronger legislation to protect water users. This resulted in a £5 billion investment by water companies dramatically changing the lives of surfers, swimmers and holidaymakers alike.

After decades of campaigning on the improvement of water quality, last years' classifications announced a fantastic 98.5% of the 625 designated bathing waters around the UK are now classified as excellent, good, or sufficient. This is a huge leap forward from when Surfers Against Sewage started in 1990 when just 27% of bathing waters could meet the same standards.

The majority of legislation ensuring bathing waters are kept clean stems from Europe. It is vital that we as a nation keep

up the pressure so that post-Brexit, the standards continue to be improved. This includes calls for an increased bathing season to cover those thousands of year-round water users.

Climate Change

The need to speak up to protect the life we love from climate change is more pressing now than ever before. Climate change impacts are being felt everywhere - from an increase in extreme weather events and marked changes in the seasons here in the UK, to more devastating effects elsewhere. Covering 71% of the planet's surface, our ocean is especially vulnerable. 2017 saw the hottest ocean temperatures ever recorded, and acidification, changing currents and rising sea levels - all caused by climate change - are significantly affecting marine life.

The UK has a huge role to play in protecting the ocean environment. With the fifth largest marine area of any nation, principally through overseas territories, and being custodian to the largest coral atoll on earth, our government must act to protect the waters that give this planet life. Progress has been made, both through policy that acts to tackle climate change and through specific marine conservation legislation. The Climate Change Act, which celebrates its 10th Anniversary this year, has been instrumental in emissions reductions over the past decade, leading to a more than 42% reduction in emissions since 1990. Ratifying the Paris Agreement - which provides a framework for governments to keep global warming well below 2 degrees - was another strong signal that the government is committed to protecting the life we love from climate change.

Encouragingly, there is also cross-party support on marine conservation in UK waters both near and far. 50 marine conservation zones have been set up in English waters and 282 MPs recently signed a charter pledging their support for the Blue Belt policy, which aims to protect 4 million square kilometres of ocean in British Overseas Territories.

There is so much more to be done, however. Parliament has made steps in the right direction, but we need to ensure that it's ambition doesn't weaken. We can all make an impact through our own lifestyle choices, but MPs have the power to make the legislative changes that are key if we're to safeguard the ocean that we love for future generations.

David Attenborough's Blue Planet II showed the power of storytelling in connecting people to the plight of our ocean, and we must continue to harness this upswell effectively if we are to see long-lasting change that will set us on the right track. In a climate where issues increasingly compete for attention, MPs are more likely to take action if they hear directly from their constituents. When we come together, as organisations and as individuals, to speak up about the ocean's vulnerability, MPs will have to listen, and once they've listened, they can act with powerful results.

As a coalition, we know the importance of collaboration. Shared knowledge, networks and expertise are key when it comes to galvanising support and encouraging MPs to take action. We have seen that we are stronger together and that our voice has more impact and more weight in Parliament when it's united as one. The principle of collaborative working applies so clearly to the issue of marine protection - the ocean knows no boundaries or borders, and what better way to reflect that than by combining forces.

Marine Protected Areas

Warming, acidification, pollution and overfishing are threatening the ocean's ability to absorb carbon dioxide, produce oxygen and feed a growing population. By protecting significant areas in the ocean, we can reverse some of the damage we are causing and make it more resilient. The good news is that when parts of the ocean are placed under meaningful protection, biodiversity recovers at an impressive rate.

Respected scientific opinion argues that more than 30% of the world's ocean needs to be put under some form of protection if the other two thirds are to be sustainably fished. The world is not yet making effective collective progress against this goal: It is estimated that less than 4% of the global ocean is currently under protection, so we have a long way to go before we are getting close to what the science says is necessary.

The UK can play a disproportionately large role in addressing this global problem: Despite being a relatively small island, the UK has the fifth largest marine zone in the world, covering 6.8 million square kilometres, mostly around its 16 overseas territories. The UK Government is showing ambition in our UK Overseas Territories, having declared the intention to place at least four million square kilometres

of ocean under a "Blue Belt" of protection by 2020. These are some of the most remote and pristine pieces of ocean left anywhere on Earth, ranging from the Antarctic to the tropical Atlantic to the Indian and Pacific Oceans. It is vital that they are protected for nature and for all mankind. We urge you to contact your MP and encourage them to continue to #backthebluebelt.

By contrast, the UK Government has been much less ambitious in the protection of its domestic waters. The seas around the British Isles have been fished for many hundreds of years, and at an industrial level for at least a century, meaning many habitats and stocks are badly damaged. The UK Government needs to do much more than write policy papers and state political ambitions about protecting its own waters. It needs to get on and start implementing these protections. It does not need to wait until after Brexit before making a start – it can do so now. We urge you to write to your MP telling him/her to tell the government to get a move on turning paper marine parks into reality.

Fisheries

Marine fisheries are of great importance in the UK, in the UK Overseas Territories and worldwide, particularly in the Global South.

According to HMG statistics, in 2016, UK vessels landed 701 thousand tonnes of sea fish into the UK and abroad with a value of £936 million. In addition to contributing to our food security, this directly employed ca. 11,800 fishers (2,300 being part-time) and supported the livelihoods of many others in related businesses. Irrespective of magnitude, of key interest is the distribution of these jobs and associated economic activities which makes them disproportionately important in UK coastal areas - places where there are often less other viable alternatives and the tradition of fishing is of great cultural importance. Fishers are important users of the marine environment and need to be central to discussions regarding enhancing UK's marine conservation network which needs to be improved - not only for the biodiversity but also those who will benefit from it in various ways as part of our growing Blue Economy. The sector potentially faces great challenges under different Brexit scenarios that warrant close attention from all Members with enhanced support to Marine Management Organisation (MMO), Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Authorities and associated research organisations such as Centre for Environment, Fisheries and Aquaculture Science (CEFAS) and universities.

The UK is custodian to vast areas of marine habitats in our UK Overseas Territories that are astoundingly rich in marine biodiversity; many with significant levels of fishing activity that are economically and culturally significant e.g. Falkland Islands, Turks and Caicos Islands. Some territories have commercial fishing excluded (British Indian Ocean Territory), while for others this activity is under discussion (Ascension Island) as part of the UK Government's Blue Belt Initiative. Typically, however, these are isolated territories with small populations and limited resources and capacities to manage their marine resources. Enhanced support from HMG is needed to ensure the great marine

treasures of the UK are effectively stewarded. The UK's universities and conservation NGO sector have contributed extensively to research and conservation efforts alongside territory governments and civil society. Some support is available from Defra's Darwin Plus Scheme, but this is oversubscribed many times over.

There are large-scale industrial fisheries operating across the ocean that are important for economies and food security but are also significant drivers of the state of marine ecological systems. Often underestimated, however is the importance of small-scale fisheries, generally working in coastal seas in the Global South. It is estimated that these fisheries produce half of the world's fish for human consumption, 90% of the fishing jobs leading to 90 million related jobs. Yet, many of these fisheries are poorly regulated. From a policy perspective, UK's support of improvements of these fisheries will contribute significantly towards Global Sustainable Development Goals (1: Poverty, 2: Hunger, 3: Health, 12: Responsible consumption and 14: Life below water). This can be accomplished through Official Development Assistance (ODA) and associated research programmes such as Global Challenges Research Fund (GCRF) and the Darwin Initiative where the UK's world-leading expertise can help effect positive change.
